



RULES AT EAGLE ROCK

- 1) Shoes must be worn at all times. There are snakes and poison ivy.
- 2) Use the Buddy System. If you want to check out a trail or something, make sure you take at least one Buddy and that you check with a staff person for permission. Always stay within view of the Lodge.
- 3) Clean up after yourself. Take responsibility for your own stuff. Keep up with your belongings. If you use something, put it away neatly where you found it. If you make a mess, spill something, or see trash lying around, take care if it.
- 4) Take good care of camp property and equipment. We are to be good stewards of all that God gives us. Keep this in mind when using Eagle Rock property. Others left it in good shape for you, so you leave it in good shape for others.
- 5) Respect other's property. Don't mess with others' stuff. Leave it alone and give no reason for harsh feelings or accusations.
- 6) Keep Bunkhouse, Barn, Dining Hall, and Lodge areas clean. We really appreciate your help, and this is a great way to thank the camp staff.
- 7) CD players, Ipods and cell phones are not allowed. This is a special time to enjoy God's creation, the company of others, and to get away from the DISTRACTIONS that surround us in our lives back home. Instead, try exploring a trail, making new friends, getting involved in group stuff, or hangin' out with God in some personal Quiet Time.
- 8) Be respectful of others' personal and Quiet time. During Quiet Time, if you choose not to participate, please don't distract or disturb others.
- 9) Phone Policy- Only retreat leaders and chaperones will have access to the phone. Upon arrival, the retreat leader will call his/her church to report their group's safe arrival. No campers will have access to the camp phone.
- 10) Audio/Video- Only retreat leaders and chaperone should operate the laptops, projectors and sound equipment.
